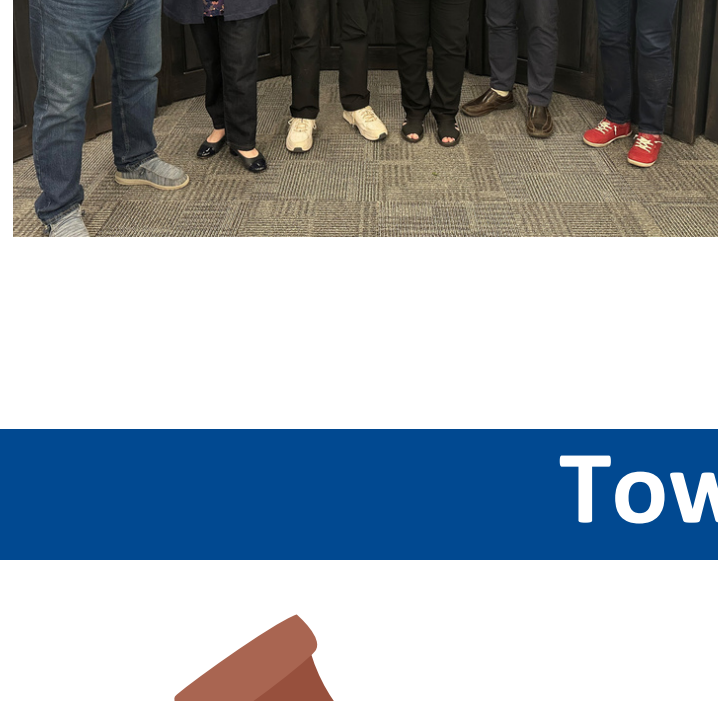
Never Forget Mailbox

May 10th Council Meeting Highlights

COMMUNITY SERVICES
Accessible Playground Equipment
 Council received correspondence from a resident asking if an accessible swing could be placed at the playground on Rowsell Boulevard. Council will explore cost options for the swing.

PLANNING AND PUBLIC WORKS
Public Transit
 Affordable public transportation will be an important consideration as Council's develops its Workforce Development Strategy. Staff will continue to research public transit options and provide further updates and recommendations when available.

PUBLIC SAFETY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES
Armstrong/Airport Intersection
 A complaint was received from a resident after getting a ticket at the intersection. Public Safety/Protective Services Committee recognizes there is a concern in the area and refers to the Planning/Public Works Committee for options.
