Both athletes have dedicated the past two years to intensive training, demonstrating resilience and commitment in their pursuit of excellence.



Support for Special Olympics Athletes: Council presented a cheque to local athletes Johnny Philpott and Michael Harris to assist with travel expenses.



Housing and Development Initiatives: Council approved several measures to accommodate diverse housing types in Gander, including amendments to the Municipal Plan to allow for more multi-unit housing and accessory dwelling units.



Community Clean-Up: Discussion on the annual Fall Clean-Up showed increased engagement with costs reported to be higher due to rising tipping fees, highlighting ongoing efforts to maintain community cleanliness.

Support for Local Sports Events: The Town approved financial support for the Atlantic Female AAA U13 Hockey Tournament in April, aiming to boost local participation and community engagement.



Waiver of Fees for Special Events: The Town agreed to waive fees for facility use during the NL Special Olympics Summer Games and Gander Collegiate graduation, demonstrating support for community events.
